

## **Restoration Hope Church Partnership Application**

At Restoration Hope Church, we call membership, partnership. Partnership within a local church carries both privileges and responsibilities. Partners of the Church are held accountable to the responsibilities of general Christian obligations comprehensively though not exhaustively outlined within the Church's Partnership Commitment. These responsibilities include praying for and pursuing both corporate health and individual holiness.

Jesus asked the Father to unify his followers so that "the world may believe that you sent me" (Jn.17:21). The apostle Paul pleaded with the church to have "the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind" (Phil.2:2). In pursuit of such unity, we will ask members of RHC to agree on a few significant points: 1) Belief in Jesus, 2) agreement on various theological/biblical positions, and 3) commitment to life together according to our Church Covenant.

The following questions are intended to help RHC leadership identify agreement with these points. Answering them will be the **first step** toward partnership with RHC. For your **second step**, we ask that you sit for a partnership interview with our pastor.
